Humidity Control and Evaporative Cooling

Humidification and cooling with reliable hygiene control and quality construction

Evaporative module

Mains or RO water is pumped to the top of the evaporative module and flows down the surface of the evaporative cassettes. As air passes through the module, it is humidified and cooled.

High quality evaporative cassettes



Long lasting and efficient glass fibre media is housed within a stainless steel cassette frame. Integrated antibacterial additives provide hygienic operation. Modular construction offers easy onsite installation. The robust cassettes have been independently certified to be non-particle releasing and to Euro Class A2-S2-D0 (UL 900) fire rating.


Flush and drain hygiene control

Regular flush and drain cycles ensure water in the system is fresh and hygienic. Water is also automatically drained during non-operation to avoid the possibility of stagnation.

Submerged UV hygiene option

Ultraviolet light kills micro-organisms in the drain tray to maintain hygienic operation.





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Multi-stage control as standard

Water is supplied to the evaporative module in up to three stages, depending on humidity demand, for more accurate humidity control.

Control panel

A multi-coloured LED provides operational status information and fault diagnostics. Flow control can be adjusted electronically, without needing to make mechanical alterations to valves. The humidifier offers BMS connectivity via Modbus.

Hydraulic unit



Incorporates up to three electronically controlled pumps, stainless steel valves and moulded plug connections, avoiding any need for wiring in the AHU. As the system operates at low voltage, it is safer for installation or maintenance technicians.

Low energy, long-life pumps



Magnetically driven impellors, with frictionless motion, give an extremely long service lifetime and are almost silent in operation. As the humidifier has multiple low energy pumps, it uses less energy that single pump systems. Operating energy consumption is proportional to output, ranging from just 74 to 145W.

The Condair MC is an in-duct evaporative humidifier that provides low energy humidification and cooling. A single unit can offer up to 360kg/h of humidity and approximately

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245kW/h of adiabatic cooling to an air handling unit.

The humidifier incorporates quality components, such as long-lasting glass fibre evaporative media and stainless steel construction. It has a PCB control panel and many integrated hygiene control features, such as anti-microbial impregnated media, UV hygiene options, and flush and drain cycles.


Intelligent modular design makes installation easy.
